

Minutes from National iMedConsent™ VANTS Call

1. CCOW/Vergence Issue

In the next couple days, Mike Palmer will be posting a message to the iMedConsent listserv. We expect that the message will include the process to request the Sentillion 3.9.1 workstation upgrade for workstations on which iMedConsent is accessed.

2. Upcoming Releases

The September release is tentatively scheduled for Friday, October 6. Please refer to the release notes for details. This release will include mostly content—no major changes to the user interface are currently anticipated. The “Against Medical Advice” (AMA) form and the Authorization for Autopsy forms will be included. There is currently no tentative schedule for the October release.

3. Image for Server Replacement

There are currently no funds allocated at the national level to replace iMedConsent servers provided in the rollout. Maintenance of these boxes, and replacement when necessary, is the responsibility of each local facility. We briefly discussed development of a protocol for seamless replacement of iMedConsent servers. I will ask Dialog Medical to work on this and provide an update on the November POC call (Wednesday, November 1, 3:00 PM Eastern, VANTS code 50498#).

4. Consent for Flu Vaccination

We talked about the VA Consent form for flu vaccination currently available in iMedConsent under the Allergy/education. There seem to be several areas of the form wizard that are in need of evaluation and possible modification. Ethics will work with Dialog Medical to resolve this issue. If you are experiencing problems with using the form wizard, use the (PRINT ONLY) version and complete it on paper until our evaluation is complete.

5. Can't close documents without saving?

A ticket has been logged with Dialog Medical support regarding the apparent inability (at least in some facilities) to close documents without saving them to the record. I will ask Dialog Medical to follow-up on this and give us an update on the November POC call.
